[AB 1843](#)

Description:

Would require poultry products treated with antibiotics containing arsenic to bear a label so indicating.

Status: Introduced 1/13/2015; Died in Committee

[SB 1844](#)

Relates to restrictions on non-therapeutic use of antimicrobial agents

Description:

Would prohibit a person from engaging in the non-therapeutic use of antimicrobial agents in cattle, poultry, sheep, swine, or any animal raised for food, including animals that provide egg and milk. Would also prohibit a person from selling or transporting any food product derived from an animal that has been subject to non-therapeutic use of antimicrobial agents.

Status: Introduced 1/11/2017
